- Mike & Diane attend Small Claims Court for ILP claim. ILP prevailed b/c the work stated was in fact completed without direction as to when to cease and desist, also the billing was similar to what ILP had previously submitted for payment. - Annual Meeting ~ Mike M. made a motion to hold SV annual meeting Wednesday December 12, 2018. Michael K second. All approved. ARA will reserve the room. BOD would like to have changing the annual meeting date on the agenda.

- Infrastructure Replacement Options Draft Spreadsheets ~ Mike & Diane met to discuss how to structure spreadsheets for presentation. Diane is working on drafts and will share with BOD asap

#### 7:10 Park

- Trees / Quote ~ Aspen Tree Service should be completing the job within the next week. Please make sure they do the ash trees by the basketball court.
- Basketball Court ~ Greg Adams first wanted to recognize the BOD for their efforts and for volunteering. Greg then spoke about his wishes for upgrading the park and specifically for an NBA type basketball set up. He also expressed his concerns in regards to safety of the equipment. Greg noted that there have been fewer people in the park since the hoops have been absent. The BOD, specifically Trevor, has been working on finding the best solution for replacement hoops etc. The BOD has agreed on one big and one small non breakaway style hoop. The hoops and all necessary accourtements will be ordered ASAP. The equipment will be installed by Mountain Maintenance.
